NAMIBIA: EXPEDITION 2

Journey Description:

An expedition journey combining all highlights of northern Namibia. Remote from civilization, lots of animals, and fantastic landscapes. This makes the heart of offroaders and campers beat faster.

Course of the Journey:

Day 1: Arrival at Windhoek around 9:15 am. Transfer, breakfast, instruction and takeover of the 4x4 vehicles. Afterwards shopping and continuation of the journey to Franz Indongo Lodge. Approx. 250km. Dinner à la carte at the lodge restaurant. Night in comfortable double rooms.

Day 2: Transferring stage to Tsumkwe. Here last opportunity to fill up with petrol. Afterwards visit of a bushman village. Half-board from the board cuisine. Night in roof tent nearby a huge Boobab tree.

Day 3: Game drive in Kaudom National Park. Flat like the savannah, but rich in animal kingdoms. The first elephants line our way. Half-board from the board cuisine. Overnight stay in roof tent in Sigaretti camp ground.

Day 4: Continuation of the journey on very sandy tracks through Kaudom Park with visit of a few water spots. The woodland grows strongly now. Many elephants, giraffes, buffalos and perhaps lions can be seen.

Half-board from the board cuisine. Night in roof tent at Kaudom camp ground makeshift showers and restroom.

Day 5: We leave Kaudom Park and move northwards over in the direction of Bangali. The landscape becomes more water abundant. Tour and bathing possibility at the Popa Falls.

Afterwards boat trip on the Okavango. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent in Ngepi camp ground shower/bathroom directly at Okavango River. Optional booking of open tree houses with shower/restroom possible.

Day 6: Day of relaxation in fantastic Ngepi Camp. Bathing and hiking opportunities.

Day 7: On the street up to Kongola. Pure off-road along Kwando River up to 4x4 Nambwa camp grounds. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent. Makeshift showers and restroom.

Day 8: Back to Kongola and continuation of the journey over Sangwali to Manilli National Park. Drive through fantastic river landscapes with much water up to the border river Chobe Botswana.

Night / Breakfast at Mazambala Lodge. Dinner à la carte.

Day 9: Back through the Caprivi National Park and transferring stage to Rundu. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent at the camp ground of the Kaisosi River Lodge shower/restroom. Optional night in double room possible.

Day 10: Time for relaxation at the pool of Kaisosi River Lodge directly at the Okavango. Optional sightseeing of Rundu. In the afternoon sundown trip on the Okavango directly at the border to Angola. Overnight stay in roof tent on the camp ground of Kaisosi River Lodge shower/bathroom. Optional overnight stay at double room possible.

Day 11: Transferring stage to Tsumeb. Time for visit of the great old German train museum. Continuation of the journey to Etoscha National Park up to Namutoni camp ground. Game drive in the afternoon. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent at Namutoni camp ground. Shower/restroom. Optional in simple rooms at the old fort.

Day 12: Game drive up to Andoni Gate. Continuation of the journey over Oshakati up to Ruacana to famous Kunene River Lodge. Breakfast at the lodge. Dinner à la carte. Night in roof tent at the camp site of the lodge. Shower/restroom. Optional air-conditioned double rooms or simple bungalows.

Day 13: Pure off-road! We drive along Kunene Rivers to Epupa Falls. The distance is only 90 Km, but the minimum driving time is 6 hours. If crocodiles are in our way or the river is flooded, it might take even longer, or we drive around it to Epupa Falls. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent at the campground. Shower/Bathroom.

Day 14: Continuation of the journey across Joubert Mountains in the Kaokofeld to Opuwo. Ovahimba, the natives of the Kaokofeld line our way. Night in luxurious tents with shower/restroom/breakfast: Mopane Camp

Day 15: Along Chumib River we reach to Puros. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent at camp ground Puros or wild.

Day 16: Across Hoahusib River over Amsport we reach imposing Hoanib River with numerous elephants, giraffes, kudus, oryx and baboons. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent.

Day 17: Continuation of the journey across Hoanib River past Sesfontain to Warmquelle. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent at camp ground Warmquelle with waterfall and little bathing lake.

Day 18: We get to know the petrified forest and will set up another camp in the middle of a mountainous region. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent at Huab River.

Day 19: The Goboboseb Mountains with their fantastic quartz and semi-precious stones are our destination. Half-board from board cuisine. Night in roof tent on a plateau.

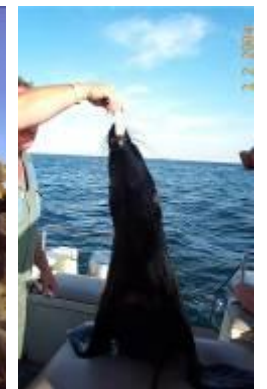
Day 20: Past Brandberg and along the coast we reach Swakopmund, a traditional city worth seeing. Check-in at a guest house. Rest of the day at one's disposal. Dinner at a traditional brewery (optional). Afterwards Swakopmund at night. Night/double room/breakfast: **PENSION RAPMUND**

Day 21: Breakfast at Probst in the morning (German coffee-house worth seeing). Afterwards we start our boat trip to Pelican Point. A boat trip exceptional of its kind. Let's wait and see what happens. Dinner at famous fish and meat restaurant "Raft" in Walvis Bay. (Optional) Night/double room in simple **LAGOON CHALETS** or similar.

Day 22: Another excursion to the desert! In Tsondab Valley an impressive desert landscape is waiting for us. Half-board at restaurant. Night in roof tent at Tsondab Valley Camp. (Optional night in lux. bungalow)

Day 23: Return journey to Windhoek. Check-in at the Roof Hotels. Night / breakfast. Farewell party and dinner at famous Joe's Beerhouse.

Day 24: Time for shopping and sightseeing on the next day. Transfer to the airport at 5pm and return flight to Germany.

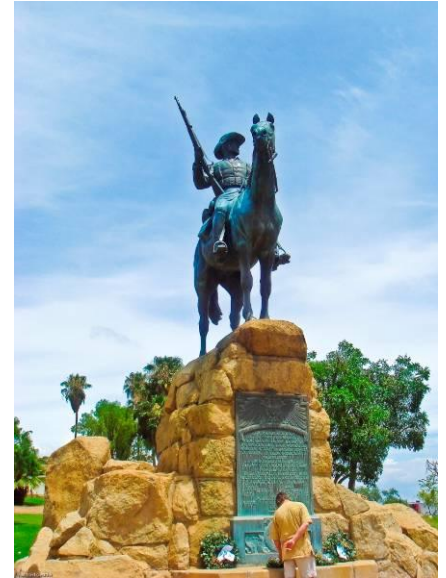

Our services include:

Direct scheduled flight from Frankfurt to Windhoek on request. Seat reservation (economy) airport tax, kerosene surcharge and airport security fee. Fully equipped 4X4 vehicles with roof tent (completely stocked with bedding, pillow and sleeping bag), bench, table, grill, camping stove and compressor fridge, 165-liter tank, canister, 2 fully adequate spare tires. All vehicles are occupied with a **maximum of 2 persons.**

Fully comprehensive vehicle insurance, (deductible of only 10000 N\$ or no deposit for 250-290N\$ per day), personal liability insurance, small vehicle repairs and possible replacement vehicle procurement when not acting with negligence. All nights in wild camps, at camp grounds with shower and restroom, Nights at guest houses or lodges, according to the course of the journey lunch snacks, half-board catering on all camp grounds and basic equipment with soft drinks (several pallets with Coca Cola, Schweppes Tonic, mineral water, orange juice or apple juice) on each vehicle. All entry fees and farewell party. Experienced guides and English-speaking guides.



Your additional costs:

Purchase of alcoholic beverages. Some dinners at different lodges. Generally all beverages consumed in lodges, guest houses or during restaurant visits. Soft drink purchase extension after usage of basic equipment. Petrol costs. Souvenirs.

On request:

Depending on the tour, the following features can be organized for extra payment:

Mud crossing with ATV quad bikes or white-water rafting. Gamed rive and lion feeding in several lodges. Some camp grounds offer nights in air-conditioned tents, double rooms or chalets. They can always be booked freely according to availability and for additional charge.



Flights:

Because of the strongly frequented flights to Windhoek between the 5th of October and 15th of March, enrolment to a journey during this time period without a surcharge is only possible up to 5 months in advance. Business Class- or XXL-seats are possible, but are mostly already booked out 6 months in advance. Please ask us about the additional costs.



Please notice:

Since we schedule the daily routine already over one year in advance and regulations and guidelines change constantly, small deviations of the description might arise. A passport valid for at least 6 months is necessary for entry. There are no vaccination regulations at the moment. However we advise you to consult your GP before departure. A malaria prophylaxis (only on stand-by basis) is recommendable for the north of Namibia during rainy season from January to May. Please consult your GP. Single room surcharge: on request. Single vehicle surcharge: on request.
