NAMIBIA: THE DESERT TRIP VARIATION 1

JOURNEY DESCRIPTION:

Especially suitable for desert lovers who also do not want to miss cultural cities and long beaches.(13 days)

COURSE OF THE JOURNEY:

Day 1: Arrival in Windhoek in the early morning. Transfer, breakfast, instruction and takeover of the 4x4 vehicles. Afterwards shopping and continuation of the journey to Harry's Farm. Time for relaxation at the jacuzzi, sunset at Harry's Rock and barbecue party. Night/half-board in simple rooms.

Day 2: Over Marienthal and Malta Height to Tiras Mountains. Fauna and flora drive. Half-board at Harry's Camp Restaurant. Night/double room/breakfast in a guest house.

Day 3: Continuation of the journey over Aus to Lüderitz. Preparation of the vehicles for Namib Desert crossing. The rest of the day at one's disposal. Night/breakfast in a guest house.

Day 4: Over 'the city of the dead' Kolmanskop to Saddle Hill. Arrival in Saddle Hill in the afternoon. Time for relaxation. Afterwards sand boarding and sunset on a high dune close to the camp. Half-board at Saddle Hill Camp. Night in simple huts with collective showers and bathrooms.

Day 5: Dune training. We drive on dunes with a height of up to 250 meters. Trip to Spencer Bay or Hottentot Bay. We will catch the dinner ourselves (lobster). Past old diamond excavation sites and ship wrecks back to Saddle Hill. Half-board at Saddle Hill Camp Night in simple huts with collective showers and bathrooms.

Day 6: We drive to the sea, visit old ship wrecks and several seal banks. We collect mussels for dinner. Farewell party in Saddle Hill. Half-board at Saddle Hill Camp. Night in simple huts with collective showers and bathrooms.

Day 7: We leave Saddle Hill and drive back across the dunes to Lüderitz. The rest of the day at one's disposal. Night/breakfast in a double room in a guest house.

Day 8: Over Aus we get northwards almost up to Sesriem. Night/breakfast in a double room in a guest house.

Day 9: Early in the morning, only strengthened by a coffee, we drive to Sossusvlei. At the edge of the most beautiful dunes of the Namib, we invite you to a champagne breakfast buffet underneath shady trees. Afterwards you have the opportunity to explore one of the highest dunes of the Death Valley on foot. Around noon continuation of the journey to Namib Desert Lodge. After relaxing at the natural stone pool for about 2 hours, we offer you an optional sunset game drive to the fossilized dunes in the close vicinity. Night/breakfast in a double room at the Namib Desert Lodge.

Day 10: Arrival in Walvisbaai in the early afternoon. The rest of the day at one's disposal. Dinner at the famous fish and meat restaurant "Raft" in Walvisbaai. Night at the Lagoon Chalets or similar (included).

Day 11: In the morning, breakfast at Probst (German coffee-house worth seeing) Afterwards boat trip to Pelican Point. A boat trip exceptional of its kind. Let's wait and see what happens. At midday, continuation of the journey to Swakopmund, a traditional town worth seeing. Check-in at a guest house. Afternoon at one's disposal. Dinner at the brewery (traditional restaurant). Afterwards Swakopmund at night. Night/double room/breakfast at PENSION RAPMUND or similar.

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Day 12: Return to Windhoek. Check-in at the Roof Hotels. Night / breakfast. Afternoon at one's disposal. Farewell party and dinner at famous Joe's Beerhouse.

Day 13: Time for shopping and sightseeing on the next day. At 5 pm transfer to the airport and return flight to Germany.

Our services include:

Direct scheduled flight from Frankfurt to Windhoek. Seat reservation (economy) airport tax, kerosene surcharge and airport security fee. Fully equipped 4X4 vehicles with roof tent (completely stocked with bedding, pillow and sleeping bag), bench, table, grill, camping stove and compressor fridge, 165-liter tank, canister, 2 fully adequate spare tires. All vehicles occupied with a **maximum of 2 pers.**

Fully comprehensive vehicle insurance, (deductible of 6000 NAD when acting with negligence), personal liability insurance, small vehicle repairs and possible replacement vehicle procurement when not acting with negligence.

All overnight stays in wild camps, campgrounds with shower and bathroom.

Nights at guest houses or lodges, according to the course of the journey lunch snacks, half-board catering at all campgrounds and basic equipment with soft drinks (several pallets with Coca Cola, Schweppes Tonic, mineral water, orange juice or apple juice) on each vehicle. All entry fees and farewell party. Experienced guides and English-speaking guides.

Your additional costs:

The following costs are to be paid by everybody themselves: Purchase of alcoholic beverages. Some dinners at different lodges (depending on the tour 2-6 times). Generally all beverages consumed in lodges, guest houses or during restaurant visits, and meals not mentioned in the journey description. Additional services such as sunset tour, game drive, white-water rafting etc.. Petrol costs.

On request:

Depending on the tour, the following features can be organized for additional payment:

A fishing trip on the open sea including deep-sea fishing. Game drive in Namib Desert Lodge. Sunset tour, flight with a hot air balloon. Some campgrounds offer overnight stays in air-conditioned tents or chalets. They can be booked freely any time according to availability and for additional charge.

FLIGHTS:

Because of the strongly frequented flights to Windhoek between the 5th of October and 15th of March, enrollment to a journey during this time period without a surcharge is only possible up to 5 months in advance. Business Class- or XXL- seats are possible, but are mostly already booked out 6 months in advance. Please ask us about the additional costs.

Please notice:

We will do absolutely everything for you in order to fulfill the journey description. Nevertheless small deviations of this journey description are possible due to for example customer wishes, weather changes or other unpredictable adversities. A passport valid for at least 6 months is necessary for entry. There are no vaccination regulations at the moment. However we advise you to consult your GP before departure. A malaria prophylaxis (only on stand-by basis) is recommendable for the north of Namibia during rainy season from January to May. Please consult your GP.
